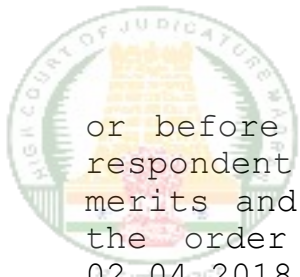
O R D E R

3.The respondent, Sub Inspector of Police, Sernthamaram Police Station, Tirunelveli District is present. On instructions, the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent submitted that if the petitioner makes a fresh representation before the respondent, the same will be considered in the light of the order passed by this Court in WP(MD)No.7043 of 2018 on 02.04.2018.

4.Considering the above submission made by the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent, it is open to the petitioner to make a fresh representation before the respondent on



or before 06.04.2018. If any such representation is received, the respondent shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law on 07.04.2018, by taking note of the order passed by this Court in WP(MD)No.7043 of 2018 dated 02.04.2018.
