Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to grant permission to conduct Adalum Padalum a cultural dance program on 28.03.2018 night as part of the temple festival and to provide adequate police protection by considering petitioner's representation dated 22.03.2018 within the time stipulated by this Court.

O R D E R

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner to direct the respondents to grant permission to conduct Adalum Padalum a cultural dance program on 28.03.2018 night as part of the temple festival and to provide adequate police protection by considering petitioner's representation dated 22.03.2018 within the time stipulated by this Court.

2.Heard Mr.S.Malaikani, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.N.Shanmugaselvam, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is one of the Villagers of the said Village. The villagers are conducting the "Adalum Padalum"



programme for the past several years and this year, they have decided to conduct the "Adalum Padalum" programme on 28.03.2018 and for that, they have already given a representation dated 22.03.2018 to the second respondent, but, sofar, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.

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4.The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents has submitted that there is a law and order problem and hence, the petitioner's representation is kept pending.

5.Considering the aforesaid submissions, the second respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 22.03.2018 and dispose of the same at early. At the time of passing order, the second respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and Ors, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Cr1.) 233.

6.With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
