COMMON PRAYER: Writ petitions filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents herein to take 50% of service rendered by the petitioner as part time vocational instructors i.e. From 02.08.1985 to 15.10.1992, 09.09.1985 to 15.10.1992 and 11.12.1984 to 31.03.1990, drawing consolidated pay along with regular service for calculating the qualifying service, for the pension purpose and the quantum of pension under Rule 43(2) of the Tamil Nadu Pension Rules by considering petitioners representation dated 24.08.2017, 26.08.2017 and 26.08.2017.
