COMMON PRAYER: Writ petitions filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents herein to take 50% of service rendered by the petitioners as part time vocational instructors i.e., from 16.09.1985 to 15.10.1992, 06.08.1980 to 31.03.1990, 15.07.1981 to 31.03.1990, 24.07.1979 to 31.03.1990, 15.07.1981 to 31.03.1990, drawing consolidated pay along with regular service for calculating the qualifying service, for the purpose pension and the quantum of pension under Rule 43(2) of the Tamil Nadu Pension Rules and to sanction pension and other pensionary benefits and also to pay arrears by considering petitioners representation dated 26.08.2017 within the time limit fixed by this Court.

2.By consent of both parties, the main Writ Petitions themselves are taken up for final disposal.

They were drawing consolidated pay along with their regular service for calculating their service for the purpose of pension.
