stage itself.

3. According to the petitioner, he has filed an application before the first respondent for issuing separate patta and the first respondent has forwarded the same to the second respondent. Thereafter, the second respondent issued a notice for conducting an enquiry, in which, both the petitioner and the third respondent have appeared during the month of December 2017 and thereafter, no order has been passed. Hence, this Writ petition is filed.

4. Considering the fact that already enquiry has been commenced, the second respondent is directed to complete the enquiry, after providing opportunity to the petitioner and also to the third respondent and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of 6 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. The Writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
