PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 341 & 506(ii) IPC in Crime No. 104 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent Police.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent Police submitted that the case is registered in Crime No.104 of 2018 for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 341, 324 & 506(ii) IPC.

4.During the temple festival, the petitioners herein scolded the de facto complainant in filthy language and also attacked the de facto complainant.



4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that the injured person has already been discharged from the hospital and there is no previous case registered against the petitioners herein.

5.Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No. VI, Trichy and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two common sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
