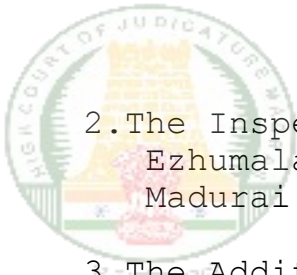
3.Recording the submission of the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
