PRAYER : Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondent to release the Tipper Lorry bearing Registration No.TN-67-F-3664 seized on 05.04.2018, to the petitioner.

O R D E R

The petitioner seeks for a writ of mandamus directing the respondent to release the Tipper Lorry bearing Registration No.TN-67-F-3664 seized on 05.04.2018.

2. According to the petitioner, even though his driver had plied the aforesaid vehicle with all relevant documents, the respondent has seized the vehicle.

3. On the other hand, it is submitted by the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent that the vehicle was seized as the same was plied without valid papers, including registration certificate books and transport permit for transporting sand.

4. In any event, as the vehicle is under the custody of the respondent having been seized on 05.04.2018 and considering the fact that if the same is allowed to be kept idle by exposing the same to sun and rain, it would certainly diminish its value. Therefore, pending proceedings before the respondent, this Court is of the view that



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- "(i) The petitioner shall produce documents before the respondent under whose custody the vehicle is kept, to establish the ownership of the vehicle in question;
- (ii) The petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) before the respondent herein;
- (iii) The petitioner shall give an undertaking that he will not use the vehicle for any illegal activities in future and shall produce the same as and when required by the respondent;
- (iv) On doing so, the vehicle in question shall be returned to the petitioner;
- (v) The petitioner shall not alienate the vehicle in question till the disposal of the proceedings before the authority concerned;
- (vi) The concerned Revenue Divisional Officer is directed to complete the enquiry within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order; and
- (vii) The petitioner is also directed to participate in the enquiry to be conducted by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer."

6. The writ petition is ordered accordingly. No costs.
