PRAYER IN SA (MD) No.SR33970 of 2015:

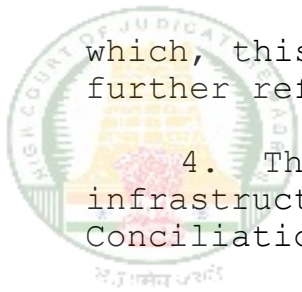

ORDER : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.P.GANAPATHI SUBRAMANIAN, Advocate for the petitioner the court made the following order:-

This petition is filed to condone the delay of 876 days in representing the appeal in S.A. (MD) SR.No.33970 of 2015.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners.
