PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

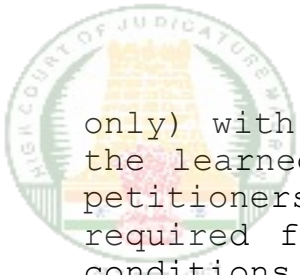
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners/ accused Nos.1 to 4 apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 336, 353 and 506(ii) IPC in Crime No.23 of 2018 and seek anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl Side) appearing for the respondent.

3.The learned Government Advocate (crl.side) appearing for the respondent submitted that pursuant to the order of this Court, the petitioners appeared in person before the respondent police and submitted a written apology.

4.Taking note of the subsequent conduct of the petitioners, this court is inclined to grant Anticipatory Bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the Judicial Magistrate Court, Thirumayam, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand



only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
