PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

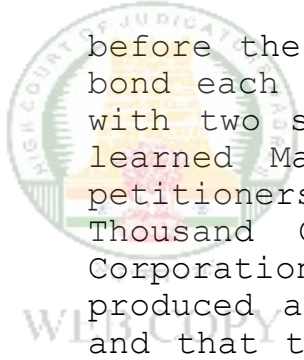
The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 336 of IPC r/w 3(1) of TNPPDL Act, in Crime No.277 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is TNSSTC Driver and on 05.04.2018 during the protest for Cauvery Management Board, the petitioners are alleged to have damaged the front glass of the TNSSTC Bus. Hence, the case has been registered for the above said offences.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners undertake to pay a sum of Rs.5,000/-to the credit of Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation and prays for anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioners.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) submitted that there is no previous case registered against the petitioners.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance



before the learned Judicial Magistrate-I, Dindigul and executing a bond each for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners are directed to deposit a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) to the credit of Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation, Dindigul Division and that the receipt of payment to be produced at the time of surrender before the concerned Magistrate and that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
