This petition has been filed to direct the 1st respondent not to harass the Petitioner under the guise of enquiry.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the 1st respondent.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the first respondent frequently called the petitioner and harassed him under the guise of enquiry.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) would submit that only on the basis of the complaint given by the second respondent, the petitioner was called for enquiry. He would further submit that the first respondent did not cause any harassment to the petitioner and it seems that the issue is purely civil in nature. Further he undertakes that the said enquiry will be disposed of within a week.

5. Recording the above said undertaking given by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side), this Criminal Original Petition is allowed. Further, the first respondent is directed not to harass the petitioner.
