This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking direction to the second respondent not to harass the Petitioner on the basis of the petitioner's representation dated 14.10.2017.

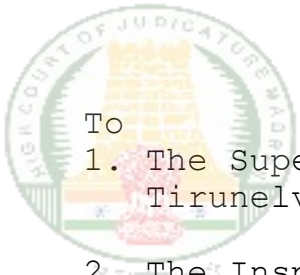
