PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner is arrayed as Accused No.1. He was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 24.03.2018 for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 294(b), 307 and 506(ii) I.P.C., in Crime No.143 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police. He seeks bail.

2.on 24.03.2018, the petitioner along with other accused have quarreled with defacto complainant and also threatened her with Aruval.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is an innocent person and that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and prays for bail in favour of the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Criminal Side) submitted that the victim girl has not suffered any injury.

5.Taking note of all these aspects, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions;



(i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Kovilpatti.

(ii) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

(iii) the petitioner shall not abscond.

(iv) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560].
