PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

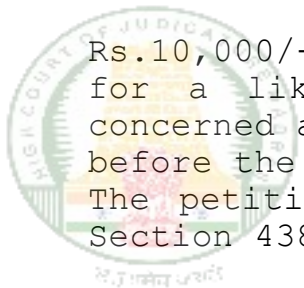
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 341, 324, 332 of I.P.C and Section 3 (1) of PDL Act , in Crime No.62 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side).

3. In this case, the TNSTC bus has been damaged. The value of the damage is Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only). Hence, the petitioners are directed to deposit a sum of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) to the credit of Crime No.62 of 2018 before the Judicial Magistrate, Pattukkottai. The TNSTC is entitled to withdraw the said amount.

4. Subject to the condition that, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Pattukottai and executing a bond for a sum of



Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
