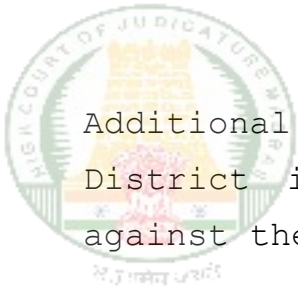
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner is figuring as second accused in S.C.No.153 of 2014 on the file of the Additional District and Sessions Judge at Nagercoil, Kanyakumari District. On account of his absence, non-bailable warrant was issued.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner shall appear regularly on all future hearing dates and if he is not in a position to appear, an application under Section 317 of Cr.P.C. would be filed. If this undertaking is breached, then this anticipatory bail order would stand cancelled automatically.

3.Recording the undertaking given by the petitioner, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Trial Court on the next hearing date for recalling the non bailable warrant. The learned



Additional District and Sessions Judge at Nagercoil, Kanyakumari District is directed to recall the non-bailable warrant issued against the petitioner on the same day.

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4. This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of, accordingly.
