PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

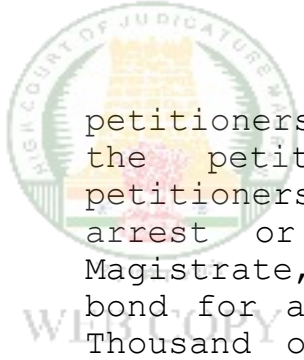
The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 434, 447 and 506(ii) IPC., in Crime No.41 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, learned counsel appearing for the intervenor and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent Police.

3. When the matter was taken up for hearing, the petitioners through their counsel filed an undertaking affidavit agreeing not to interfere with the rights of the defacto complainant and that they would work out their rights only in the manner known to law.

4. Recording the said undertaking affidavit filed by the



petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manapparai, Trichy District and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two common sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
