2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

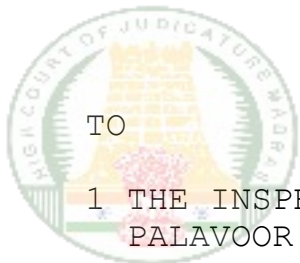
3.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) submitted that the petitioner is having eight previous cases.
