3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent Police submits that based on the complaint petition enquiry was conducted and the same was closed.

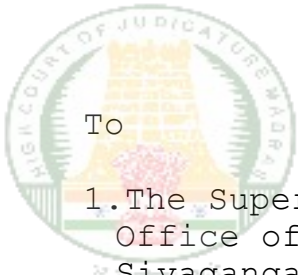
4.The same is recorded. It is made clear, now that the complaint has been closed, the respondent Police shall not call the petitioner under the guise of enquiry and harass him.
