PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 362, 365 I.P.C r/w Section 3 and 4 of the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Charging Exorbitant Interest Act, 2003, in Crime No.72 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) submitted that the injured has been discharged.

4.The petitioner had advanced a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- to the defacto complainant. In this regard, there was a dispute between the petitioner and the defacto complainant.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kuzhithurai, Kanyakumari District and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of



the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
