ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 417 and 376 IPC in Crime No.10 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) appearing for the respondent Police.

3.This Court given anticipatory bail in favour of A2 as there is no specific overt act against him. So far as the petitioner herein is concerned, specific allegations are there. In this case the de facto complainant alleged that she has been raped.



4. The allegations against the petitioner herein are serious in nature. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
