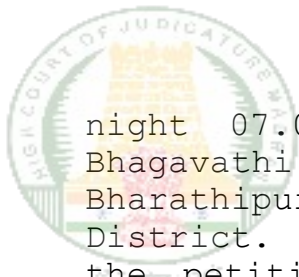

The petitioner shall enclose a copy of a representation dated 08.03.2018 along with a copy of this order to the second respondent.

6.This writ petition is disposed of, with the above direction. No costs.
