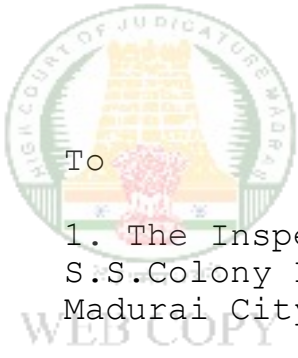
4. Recording the submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
