PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

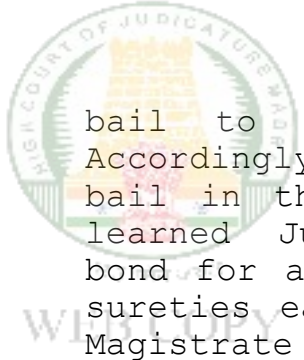
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners are apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 323, 506(ii) IPC in Crime No. Not Known of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent Police.

3.When the matter was taken up for hearing, prosecution submitted that petitioners No.2 & 4 are not accused in this case. Therefore, this Criminal Original Petition is closed as regards petitioners No.2 & 4. This case only against the petitioners No.1 & 3.

4.Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioners No.1 & 3, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory



bail to the petitioners No.1 & 3 with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners No.1 & 3 are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners No.1 & 3 shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners No.1 & 3 shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

5.The petitioners No.1 & 3 shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
