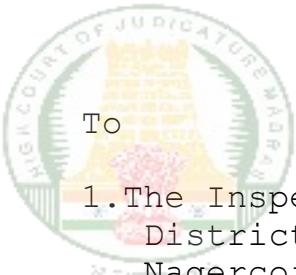
3.The learned Counsel for the petitioner disputed the said fact and sought liberty to approach the competent criminal Court in the manner known to law.
