3.Recording the said statement made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this Criminal Original petition is dismissed as infructuous.

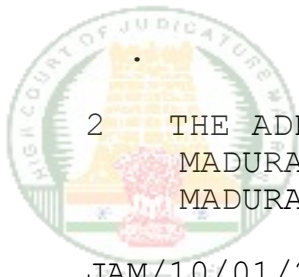
