PRAYER IN CMA(MD)NO.18771 OF 2018

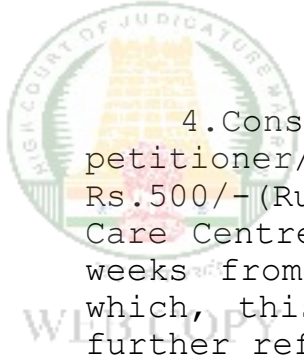
