PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 342 and 307 IPC, in Crime No.70 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner/A1 and A2 are friends. There was a quarrel between the de-facto complainant and A2 relating to electricity problem, as a result of which, on 04.04.2018, the petitioner assaulted the de-facto complainant with knife and thereby, caused injury to the de-facto complainant.

3.It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and prays for anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner.

4.It is submitted by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) that the injured person had already been discharged from the hospital and there is no previous case registered against the petitioner.

5.Taking note of the above said facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be



released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Palani, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
