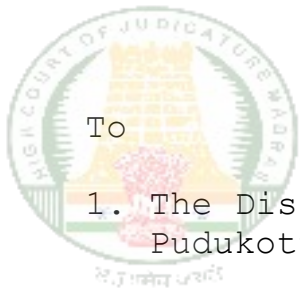
This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to direct the second respondent police to register the complaint on the basis of the petitioner's complaint dated 06.11.2017.
