PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Section 498(A) IPC and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, in Crime No.Not Known of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.It is the case of matrimonial dispute. Till date, no FIR has been registered. Since the petitioners legitimately apprehend the possibility of arrest, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to them with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judge, Additional Mahila Court, Judicial Magistrate Level, Madurai, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

3.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate



within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
