PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

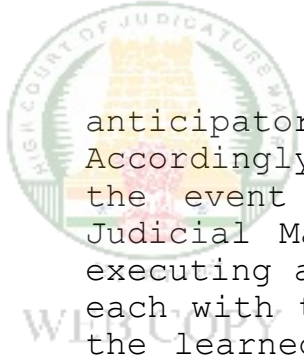
The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the offences under Sections 294(b), 498 (A) and 406 of I.P.C. and Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act in Crime No.09 of 2018 and seek anticipatory bail. They have been shown as Accused Nos.1 to 9.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl Side) appearing for the respondent.

3.The first petitioner / Accused No.1 undertakes to pay a sum of Rs.1,000/- to the *de facto* complainant every month by way of money order.

4.Recording this undertaking, this Court is inclined to grant



anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Srivaikundam, Tuticorin District and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two common sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
