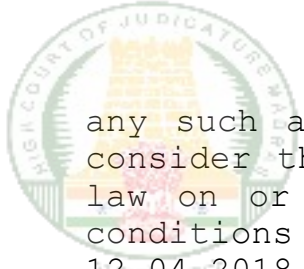

The petitioner has made a representation to the respondents on 21.04.2018, seeking permission to conduct Adal-Padal Cultural Program which is scheduled to be held on 09.05.2018 at Sri Muthallamman Temple Festival, Kottaipatti Village, Srivilliputhur Taluk, Virudhunagar District.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents.

3. The application shall be submitted only by the trustees of the Temple or the committee of the Vizha Kzhuvinar or the organizers of the festival committee before the concerned respondent police. The petitioner has made a representation only on individual capacity. Therefore, the prayer sought for by the petitioner cannot be granted. Further, the programme is to be held on 09.05.2018. Therefore, it is open to the petitioner to make a fresh representation along with the order copy to the third respondent. If



any such application is made, the third respondent is directed to consider the same and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law on or before 08.05.2018, by taking into consideration of the conditions imposed by this Court in W.P.(MD)No.7911 of 2018 dated 12.04.2018, if there is no rival claim to conduct the festival.

4. With the above direction, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
