PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

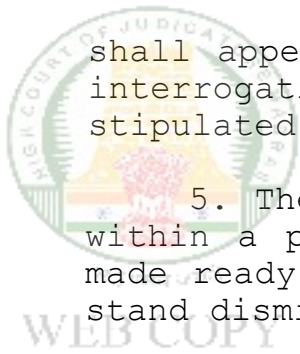
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 & 506(ii) of I.P.C. and Section 4 of the T.N.P.H.W. Act, in Crime No.28 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that due to previous enmity a false complaint has been lodged by the defacto complainant and prays for anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) submitted that the victim has been discharged from the hospital.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Mudukulathur and executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner



shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
