Therefore, this Court may pass appropriate orders to consider the petitioner's representation on merits and in accordance with law.

5.Considering the submission made by both parties, this Court directs the third respondent to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 10.04.2018 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, after providing opportunity to all the parties concerned.

6.With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
