2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that a case has been registered against the petitioners for the offence under Section 6 of the Indecent Representation of Women (Prohibition) Act, 1986 in Crime No.163 of 2012 and after completing the investigation, closure report has been filed before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Srivilliputhur. Therefore, there is no harassment by the respondent police as alleged by the petitioners.

3.In view of the above, nothing survives for further adjudication in this Criminal Original Petition. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
