COMMON ORDER

The Criminal Original Petition in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.15123 of 2016 has been filed seeking for a direction to the 6th respondent not to compel the petitioner to execute a deed towards cancelling the sale deed dated 03.02.2016 in respect of the petitioner's property situated in Plot Nos.71 and 72, Masi Theru, Thenkasi, Tirunelveli District and further direct him not to interfere into the civil subject matter in respect of the said property.

3.Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondents Police.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondents 1 to 5 submits that based on the complaint petition enquiry was conducted and the same was closed.

5.The same is recorded. It is made clear, now that the complaint has been closed, the respondent Police shall not call the petitioner under the guise of enquiry and harass him.

6.With the above direction, these Criminal Original Petitions are closed.

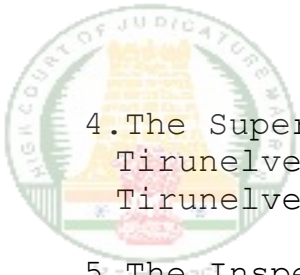
