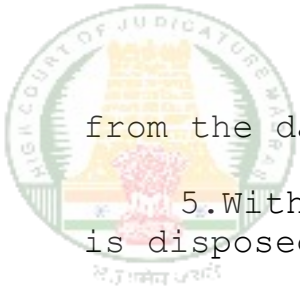
ORDER

The entire exercise shall be completed within a period of two weeks



from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
