2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

3.According to the petitioner, he made a representation dated 23.04.2018 to the respondents to give police protection to the petitioner's village temple festival of Ārulmigu Sri Hama Mariamman Kovil"which will be held on 29.04.2018 to 01.05.2018. As no order has been passed in the said representation, the petitioner has filed this writ petition with the aforesaid prayer.
