For Respondent ... Mr.K.K.Senthil

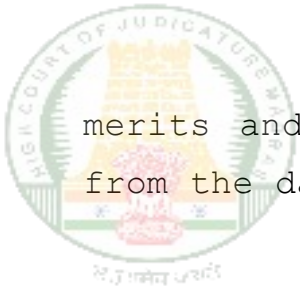
ORDER
