PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner is in judicial custody since 02.06.2018 for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 506(i), 306 I.P.C r/w Section 511 I.P.C and Section 4 of TNPWH Act, in Crime No.254 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police. He seeks bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) for the respondent.

3.The activities of the petitioner have caused serious embarrassment to the defacto complainant's daughter. Today, the petitioner's mother appeared before this Court in person. She filed an undertaking affidavit stating that she will keep on watching over her son's activities and he will not involve in the similar activities in future.

4.Recording the aforesaid undertaking, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions;

(i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Valliyoer.



(ii) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

(iii) the petitioner shall not abscond.

(iv) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560].
