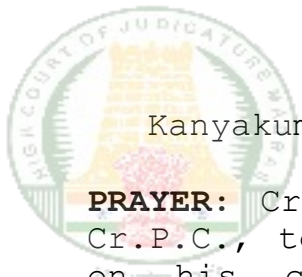

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondents Police submits that based on the complaint petition enquiry was conducted and the same was closed.

4.The same is recorded. It is made clear, now that the complaint has been closed, the respondent Police shall not call the petitioner in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.15988 of 2016 under the guise of enquiry and harass him.

5.With the above direction, these Criminal Original Petitions are closed.
