PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

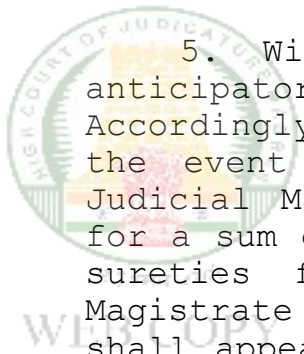
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners are apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 447 of IPC and Section 3 of TNPPDL Act, in Crime No. 247 of 2014, seek anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Cr1.Side) appearing for the respondent.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Cr1.Side) submitted that the co-accused in this case were granted relief by directing them to pay Rs.15,000/-(Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) each.

4. Imposing the same condition, the petitioners are directed to deposit Rs.15,000/-(Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) each to the Credit of Crime No.247 of 2014 before the concerned Judicial Magistrate. It is open to the defacto complainant to withdraw the said amount.



5. With this direction, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Cheranmahadevi and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two common sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
