PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused Nos.1 & 2, in Crime No.99 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 147, 294(b) and 506(i) of I.P.C and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

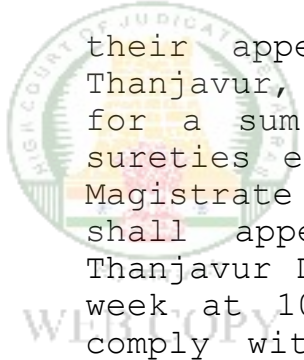
2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent/State.

3.The allegation against the petitioners is that at the instigation of the petitioners, some unknown persons unlawfully assembled together and threatened the complainant.

4.On the side of the petitioners, it is stated that the petitioners are innocents and hence prayed that the petitioners may be released on anticipatory bail.

5.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) fairly admitted that the offence is mere threatening.

6.Since the offence is only threatening and no weapon is used, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on



their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Thanjavur, Thanjavur District and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Thanjavur, Thanjavur District once in a week i.e on the first working of every week at 10.30 a.m., until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
