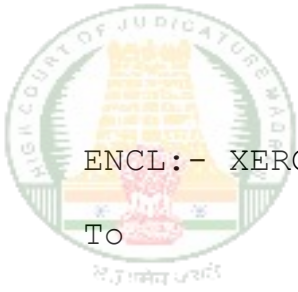
A mediation agreement report has been received by this Court and it is seen that the parties have settled the matter among themselves by virtue of an agreement entered into between them on 08.12.2016.
