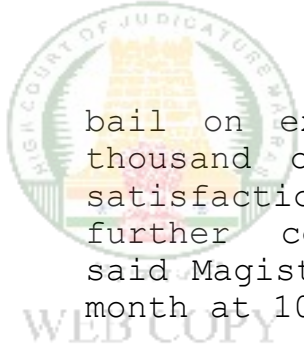
This petition has been filed by the petitioner to suspend the sentence imposed by the learned Sessions Judge, Mahila Fast Track Court, Dindigul in Spl.S.C.No.9 of 2016 dated 06.04.2018 and enlarge the petitioner on bail, pending disposal of the present Criminal Appeal.

2. Heard both sides.

3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and upon hearing the learned counsel appearing for both sides, this Court is of the view that the petitioner could be granted the relief as prayed for with certain conditions.

4. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on



bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Mahila Fast Track Court, Dindigul and on further condition that the petitioner should report before the said Magistrate, on the first working day of every English calendar month at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.
