PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Heard both sides.

2.The petitioner was arrested on 07.05.2018 for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 332, 353, 379 and 307 IPC, in Crime No.59 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

3.The case of the prosecution is that the accused 1 and 2 had transported sand illegally in the vehicle of the petitioner herein.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner herein is the owner of the vehicle. He further submitted that the co-accused were granted anticipatory bail by this Court.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking note of the period of incarceration of the petitioner and also considering the fact that the co-accused were granted anticipatory bail, I am of the view that the petitioner could be enlarged on bail. Accordingly, it is ordered that the petitioner shall be released on bail, on executing a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate-2, Ramanathapuram and on further condition that the petitioner shall



report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.
