In view of the limited prayer sought for and without going into the merits of the petitioner's representation dated 09.05.2018, there shall be a direction to the second and third respondent to consider the petitioner's representation on its own merits and pass appropriate orders within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Such an exercise shall be done after giving due opportunity to the petitioner and to any other person who may be interested in the subject matter.

5. With the above observation, this writ petition stands allowed. No costs.
