PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

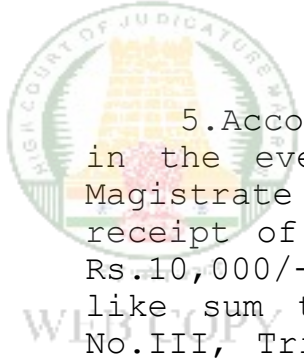
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Section 174 of Cr.P.C., which was subsequently, altered into Section 306 IPC and seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) submitted that the co-accused have already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the co-accused have already been granted anticipatory bail and since the overt act alleged against the petitioner is not serious as that of the other co-accused, this Court is inclined to grant the relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Magistrate concerned within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Trichy, or to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer, who intends to arrest and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.
