The petitioner, who is the husband of the detenu has come forward to file this Habeas Corpus Petition seeking production of her wife viz., Uma before this Court from illegal custody of third respondent.

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that this is a case of elopement and the detenu is 32 years old and she voluntarily left the matrimonial home along with the third respondent.



3. In view of the above, we do not find any illegal detention involved. Accordingly, the Habeas Corpus Petition is closed.
