PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners are apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(a), 506(ii) IPC and Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Exorbitant Act in Crime No.Not Known of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.It is seen that the petitioners had issued legal notice demanding specific performance. The specific case of the petitioners is that the present complaint has been lodged as a counter blast. It is also seen that no injury to be caused to the de facto complainant.

3.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side).

4.Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Uthamapalayam, Theni District and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of



the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
